Main Street community stakeholder focus sessions were held March 15 and 16. The Partnership held five focus group sessions with over 50 people (business owners, building owners, elected officials and partner agencies) in attendance! Additionally, there were 417 responses to the community survey. At each session, Main Street staff reviewed the *Main Street Approach* and asked attendees a series of questions about their vision for downtown.
